- methods of assessing specific situations and making decisions about the directions of development of the national economy of the Republic of Belarus.

To understand the features and mechanism of functioning of the national economy, to assess the resource potential and competitive advantages, to determine the trends and prospects of its development to solve current economic problems and implement the strategic goals and objectives of development of the Republic of Belarus.
