1. Course outline

The discipline "Economics of the Enterprise" in terms of content characterizes the sphere of effective functioning and development of the production and economic activities of enterprises (organizations).

2. Course learning outcomes:

- know: features of the current stage of development of the economy of the republic; methods for implementing the economic laws of development of an enterprise (organization); features of the functioning of the enterprise (organization); methods for substantiating economic decisions; the essence of the main economic categories and concepts (fixed, circulating and labor capital, labor productivity, cost, profit, income, profitability, economic efficiency, etc.); depreciation methods; innovative and investment activities of an enterprise (organization) in modern conditions; sources and factors for reducing the cost of production (works, services) and its impact on the competitiveness of the enterprise and production; ways to increase profits and profitability; scientific foundations and ways to improve production efficiency, save all types of resources;
- be able to: use normative and technical documentation; formulate and solve economic problems; make payments for the work performed; perform technical and economic calculations and economically justify the decisions made in the framework of future professional activities; perform calculations of the economic efficiency of innovations;
- possess: the legal framework that regulates the economy of the enterprise; methods for calculating economic indicators; methodology of economic analysis and evaluation of management decisions.
