1. Course outline

The discipline "Transport Law" in content characterizes the legal foundations of relations in transport and their legal regulation.

2 Course learning outcomes:

- know: the structure of transport legislation; legal norms governing relations during the transportation of passengers, baggage, cargo by transport in various types of messages; legal status of carriers; legal aspects of coordinating the volume of transportation, organizing and implementing the delivery of goods; legal norms that determine the responsibility of carriers, consignors, consignees in the delivery of goods;
- be able to: organize and carry out the transportation of passengers, baggage, cargo in accordance with applicable legal norms and provisions of contracts; to organize work on the conclusion of contracts and act-claim work at the enterprise; give qualified advice to passengers, consignors, consignees on their rights and obligations, the application of the rules governing the transportation of passengers, baggage and goods by transport; determine the guilty party and the extent of liability in case of violation of the provisions of regulatory legal acts and transportation contracts in force on transport; competently consider and resolve issues related to the presentation and consideration of claims, the content of claim statements arising during transportation;
- possess: knowledge of the procedure for resolving disputes between carriers and business entities, citizens; the skills of a qualified assessment of the legal possibilities and consequences of decisions made in the field of legal regulation of relations in the organization and implementation of transportation by transport; knowledge about the work of economic courts of the Republic of Belarus.
