- **1. Course outline:** the essence and types of risk; risk management system at the enterprise; methodology of risk analysis and assessment; risk analysis and assessment of financial and economic activities; risk management at the enterprise; economic essence of insurance; organization of insurance activities in the Republic of Belarus; insurance rates; types and practice of insurance in transport activities.
