1. Brief content of the academic discipline: The concept of economic law. State regulation of economic activity. Legal regime of property of business entities. Legal regulation of accounting, reporting and analysis. Legal status of business entities. Business contract. Responsibility in economic legal relations. Legal regulation of trade. Legal support of the paid transfer of property for temporary use. Legal regulation of economic relations for the performance of work. Legal regulation of freight traffic. Legal bases of investment activity. Legal regulation of economic insolvency (bankruptcy). Legal regulation of counteraction to monopolistic activity and support of competition. Legal regulation of foreign trade activity. The procedure for consideration and resolution of economic disputes.
