1. Course outline

Formation of a system of professional knowledge and skills in students in the field of technical expertise and evaluation of motor vehicles, in particular, damaged as a result of a traffic accident (hereinafter referred to as an accident), as well as additional theoretical knowledge and practical skills in the field of maintenance and car body repair.
