1. Course outline

Pre-diploma practice is one of the final stages in the training of mechanical engineers in the specialty 1-37 01 07 "Vehicle service", which is the beginning and basis for the implementation of graduation projects (GP). It can be carried out at the department "Technical operation of vehicles", in organizations of a car service center (CSC) and a cargo car service center (CCSC), and other business entities.

The purpose of undergraduate practice is to collect and systematize the material necessary to complete the sections of the GP.

2. Course learning outcomes

The objectives of the practice are:

- mastering and consolidating the knowledge and skills of students obtained at the university throughout the course of study;
- checking the possibilities of independent work of the future specialist in the conditions of a particular production;
- familiarization with the technical documentation for the construction of CCSC and CSC, their production units;
- collection and analysis of technical and economic indicators of CCSC and CSC;
- collection and analysis of materials on the technological, design parts of the GP;
- collection and analysis of material on the research part of the GP;
- collection and analysis of materials on the economic part of the GP;
- development of measures and recommendations to improve the efficiency of the CCSC and CSC as a whole, production zones and sites, process equipment, labor and environmental protection, etc., which should be reflected in the relevant sections developed by the GP.
