- **1. be able to: use formational and civilizational approaches to the study of the features of the historical development of the Belarusian people; characterize the conditions and results of the formation of the Belarusian ethnos in certain historical periods; carry out a comparative analysis of reforms and revolutions in the process of modernization of the Belarusian society, evaluate the results of the functioning of the Soviet socio-political system of the Belarus; determine the essential characteristics of the Belarusian model of socio-economic development; evaluate the significance of the Victory of the Soviet people in the Great Patriotic War, characterize the contribution of the Belarusian people to the struggle against fascism; analyze the process of formation of the Belarusian statehood, registration and consolidation of the sovereignty of the Republic of Belarus; characterize the process of creating the geopolitical position of the Belarusian lands in certain historical periods, analyze the place and role of the sovereign Republic of Belarus in the modern world, in the context of integration and globalization; possess: have an interdisciplinary approach to problem solving; have research skills; own system and comparative analysis; master the skills of independent work.
