#### 1. Course outline

The concept of economic law. State regulation of economic activity. The legal regime of the property of business entities. Legal regulation of accounting, reporting and analysis. The legal status of business entities. Business agreement. Responsibility in economic relations. Legal regulation of trade turnover. Legal support for the paid transfer of property for temporary use. Legal regulation of economic relations for the performance of work. Legal regulation of freight transportation. The legal basis of investment activity. Legal regulation of economic insolvency (bankruptcy). Legal regulation of counteraction to monopolistic activity and support of competition. Legal regulation of foreign trade activities. The procedure for consideration and resolution of economic disputes.
