1. Course outline: Theoretical foundations of legal regulation. The essence and features of legal relations in transportation. Transportation contracts. Legal regulation of transportation by road transport. Legal regulation of transportation by railway transport. Legal regulation of air transportation. Legal regulation of transportation by sea and inland water transport. Legal regulation of transportation by urban electric transport. Legal regulation of international transportation. Economic essence of insurance. Organization of insurance activity. Insurance tariffs. Types and practice of insurance in transportation activities.

2. Course learning outcomes: upon completion of the course, students will be expected to:

- **know:** the main categories and concepts of law, the system of transport legislation; the procedure for resolving disputes related to the implementation of transport activities; the main tasks and functions of state regulation and management of cargo transportation; goals and objectives of insurance of transport enterprises; characteristics of insurance and terminological features; methodological principles of insurance; various types of personal, property insurance, liability insurance, etc. in transport;

- **be able to:** determine the essential characteristics of concepts and categories of transport legal relations; use existing legal norms in the organization of cargo and passenger transportation of different types of transport; analyze and evaluate the current state of the insurance market of transport activities; work with claims and lawsuits arising in the course of transport activities; identify and classify different types of insurance; use knowledge of risk management, insurance and reinsurance in professional activities.

- **to possess a skill:** applying the provisions of legislation in the field of cargo transportation; making managerial decisions and insuring risks in transport activities.

3. Competencies: To apply the requirements of regulatory legal acts when carrying out transport activities, to make the optimal choice of the insurance system of a transport and logistics organization.
